This is in addition to evidence of 6 (six) contested cases in the last 5 (five) years of Judgment obtained in any superior court of record; or
 - (ii) Satisfactory and consistent display of sound and mature judgment in the office as a Chief Registrar or Chief Magistrate/Area Court President Gd.I; and/or
 - (iii) Credible record of teaching law, legal research in a reputable University and publication of Legal works.
