IN EDO STATE IN 2022**


I am directed by the Hon. Chief Judge and Chairman, Judicial Service Commission, Edo State to refer to the above-mentioned subject and to invite the attention of candidates in the on-going exercise to the provisions of the 2014 Revised National Judicial Council (N.J.C.) Guidelines and Procedural Rules, particularly Rule Four, sub Rule 4(ii)a, d and h thereof. For the avoidance of doubt, the portion of the said 2014 N.J.C. Guidelines and Procedural Rules is as reproduced hereunder, please.

Rule four (4(ii)a, d and h)

“ii. consider that:

candidates for the high office of Judicial Officers of the Superior Courts of Record including Court of Appeal and Supreme Court of Nigeria, shall be disqualified and shall not be recommended for appointment if found to have been involved in:

- (a) canvassing or lobbying for the appointment directly or indirectly in any form and/or through any person or persons, such as but not limited to, politicians, traditional rulers, public officers or other Judicial Officers;
- (d) influence peddling;
- (h) submission of false credentials and or deceitful or fraudulent curriculum vitae.”
